Extra Curricular Activities



Active Schools and a member of our Parent Council have been working with local clubs to try and organise some volunteers for after school clubs. We now have a few things in place including 2 volunteer teachers for netball for P7, an SFA football coach for P6, a volunteer basketball coach for P5, Bearsden Academy Young Leaders for dance for P3 and parents and a volunteer teacher who will be running a minifit club for P4 after the October break (details to follow). PVG checks are completed.

As we can only have 1 sports club running each day we are also looking for volunteers who could offer something different – chess, sewing, art, music, board games, book club, etc. If you have a skill you would be willing to share please contact the school office and we will carry out the necessary PVG checks and create a plan with you. The choir will also support this event and entertain the audience with a few songs. The performances will take place in the afternoon and evening (6:30pm). Information about tickets will follow nearer the time.

Absences

The following information related to absences was shared and discussed with the Parent Council last month. Between Sept 2021- Sept 2022 there were over 2500 days of absence. 1725 days were for authorised absence which is approximately 5 days per child. This would be in line with our attendance targets and we do not ever expect children to come to school when they are unwell. However, there were over 800 days of unauthorised absence (mostly for family holidays). The unauthorised absence accounts for 32% of Mosshead absences and research shows this has a significant affect on pupil's learning as well as adding greatly to staff workload as they have to help with lost learning time. The attendance officer will be supporting the school to improve the unauthorised absence rates and may be in touch with you if you plan holidays during term time. We would ask you again not to take your children out of school for any additional days unless it is for illness.
