Ms Turnbull has been working with the Junior Road Safety Officers and Sustrans to pull together an extensive programme of cycling and scootering for next term. This will include sessions for P1s who need assistance with learning to ride a bike, cycle skills for P5, bikeability training for P6, led cycle rides for P7, ibike breakfast club session for P1-3 then P4-7 for those who ride, scooter or walk to school, Beep Beep Road Safety Day for P1-3 and a whole school Big Pedal Challenge Event! Details about all of these events and activities will follow from Ms Turnbull. We have also managed to get a donation of 30 scooters for the school to help support physical activity.
